



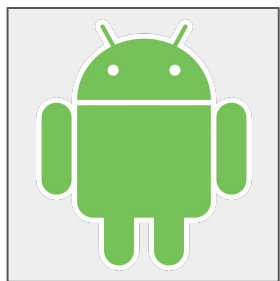

# Screen Sharing from your iPhone/iPad or Android Device



You can connect your iPhone/iPad to your computer by USB to share your Apple device screen. Then you can annotate your device screen from your computer.



You will need to join a meeting from your Android device to share your Android device screen. Then you can annotate on your device screen.



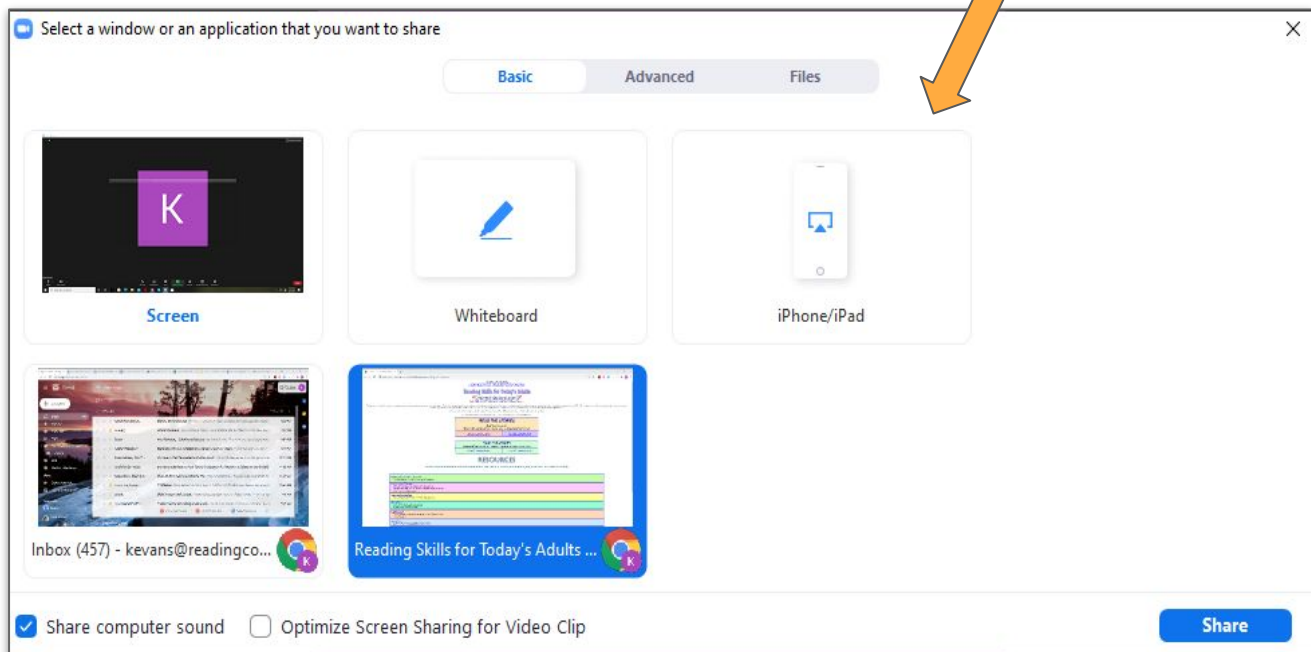

-Share your iPhone/iPad screen-

Connect your device to your computer via a USB cord.

Choose the iPhone/iPad option.



You will see this instruction screen.

## On your iPhone or iPad:

1. Connect to Wi-Fi network **kk's wifi**
2. Tap  **Screen Mirroring**  
How to find it: swipe down from the top right corner of the screen  
On iOS 11 or earlier, swipe up from the bottom of the screen
3. Choose **Zoom-kjeco**  
Don't see it? Restart your device





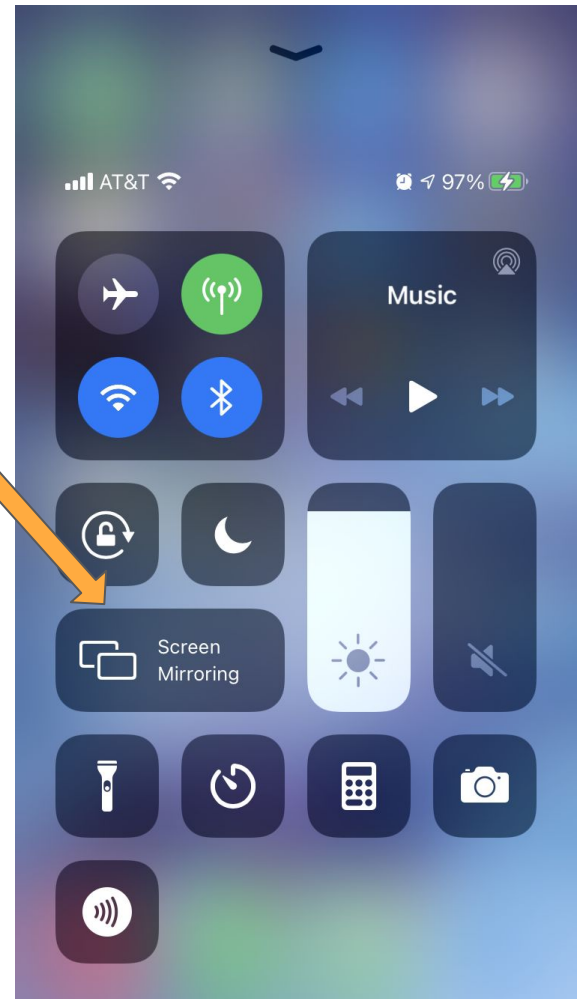
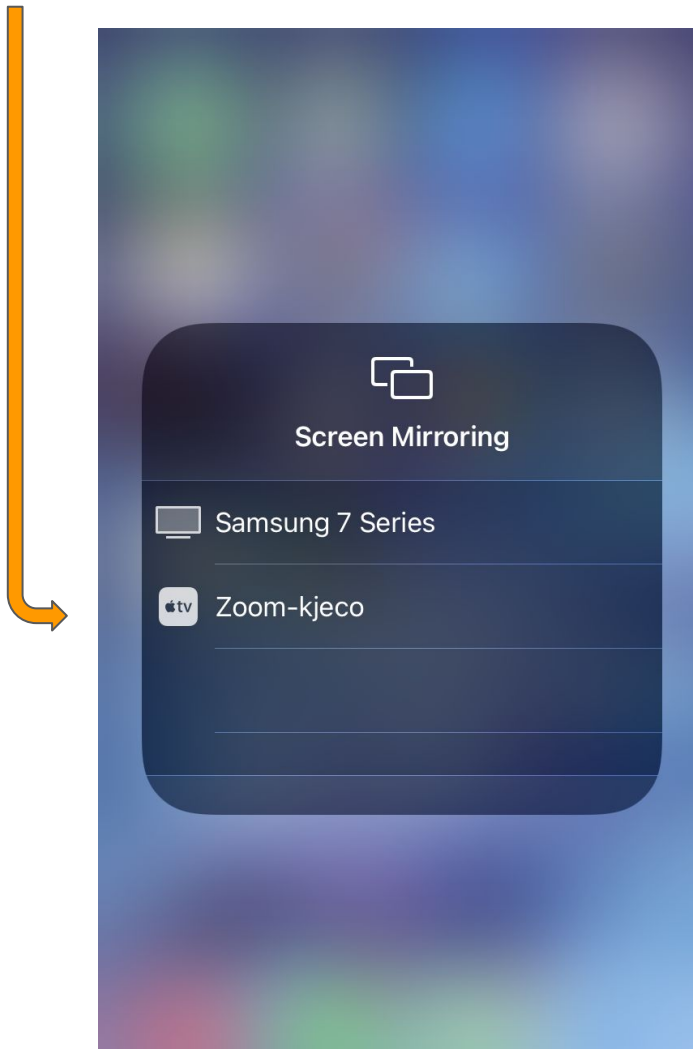

Swipe up to view this screen. Tap 'Screen Mirroring'.

A second screen will open. Tap the icon for your device.



## Important Note:

Phone notifications will appear as usual while screen sharing unless you adjust your phone settings.



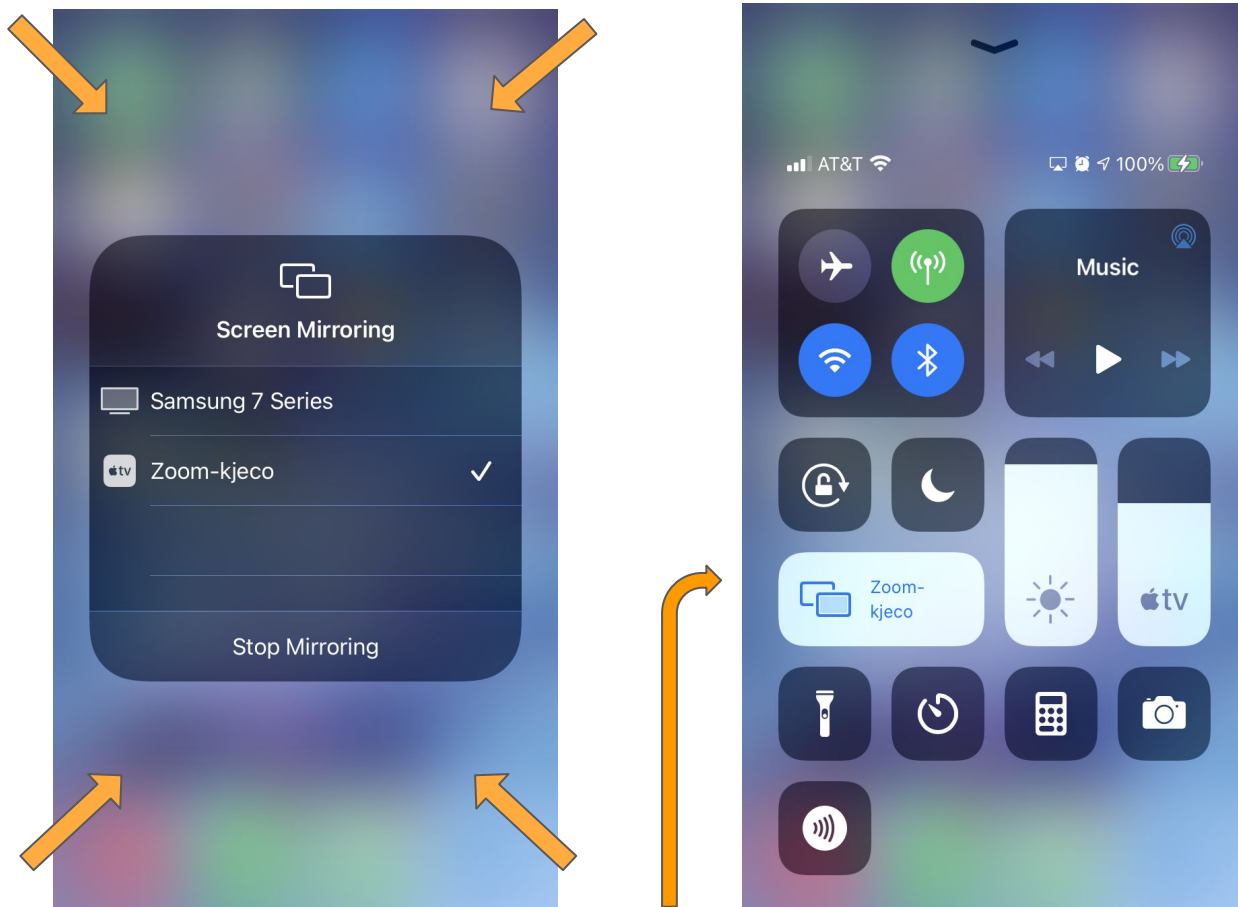


# Screen Sharing

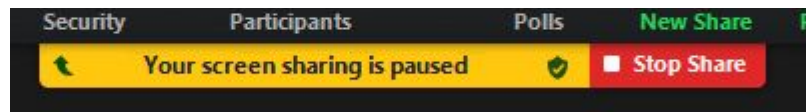

-Share your iPhone/iPad-

You are now sharing your screen. Tap anywhere outside of the 'Screen Mirroring' window to return to your phone controls.



To quickly pause and unpause the share, swipe up and tap the white screen sharing icon. Stop the share from your computer's controlbar.



You can annotate your phone screen as it appears on your computer. Just use the Zoom annotate toolbar on your computer.

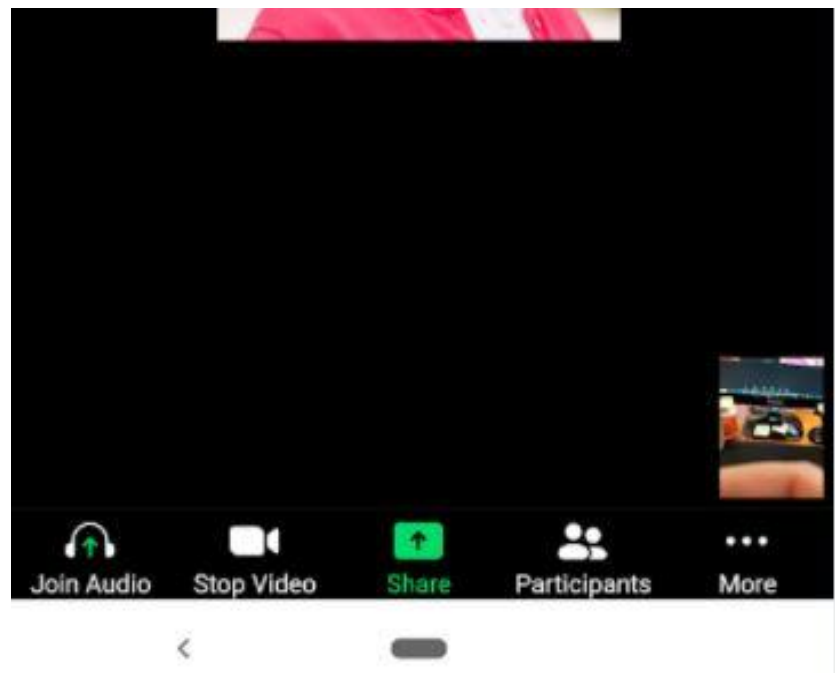
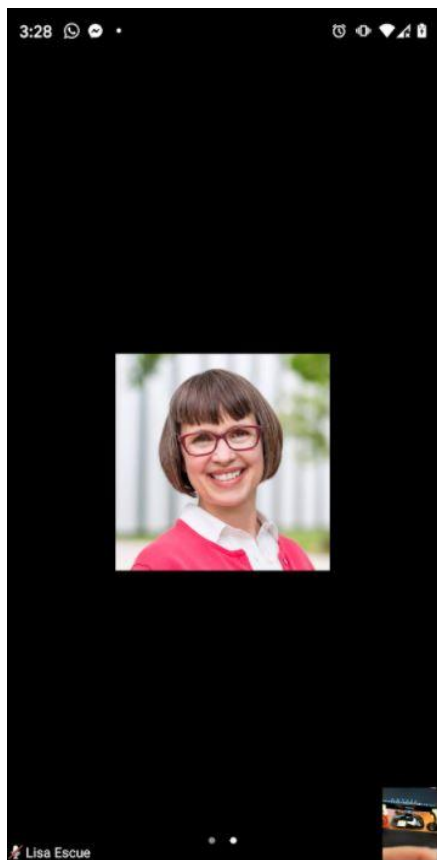
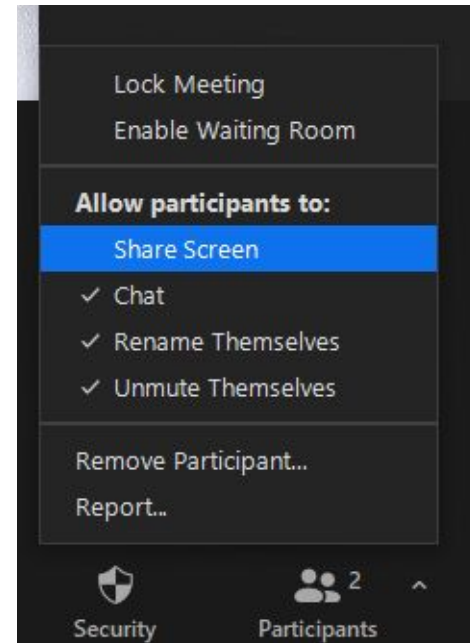

## -Share your Android Device-

Open the Zoom app on your phone.  
Join the Zoom meeting from your phone as an additional participant.

On your desktop, click 'Security' and give permission to share.

On your phone, tap the screen to make the Zoom controls appear.  
Then, tap 'Share'.





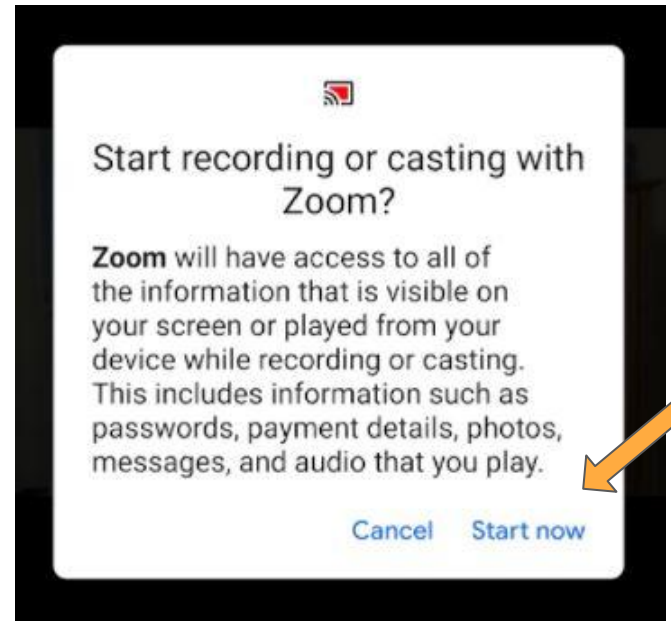

## -Share your Android Device-

Click "Start now". You are now sharing your screen.

Tap the arrow for the screen sharing toolbar.



The screen sharing toolbar will expand.

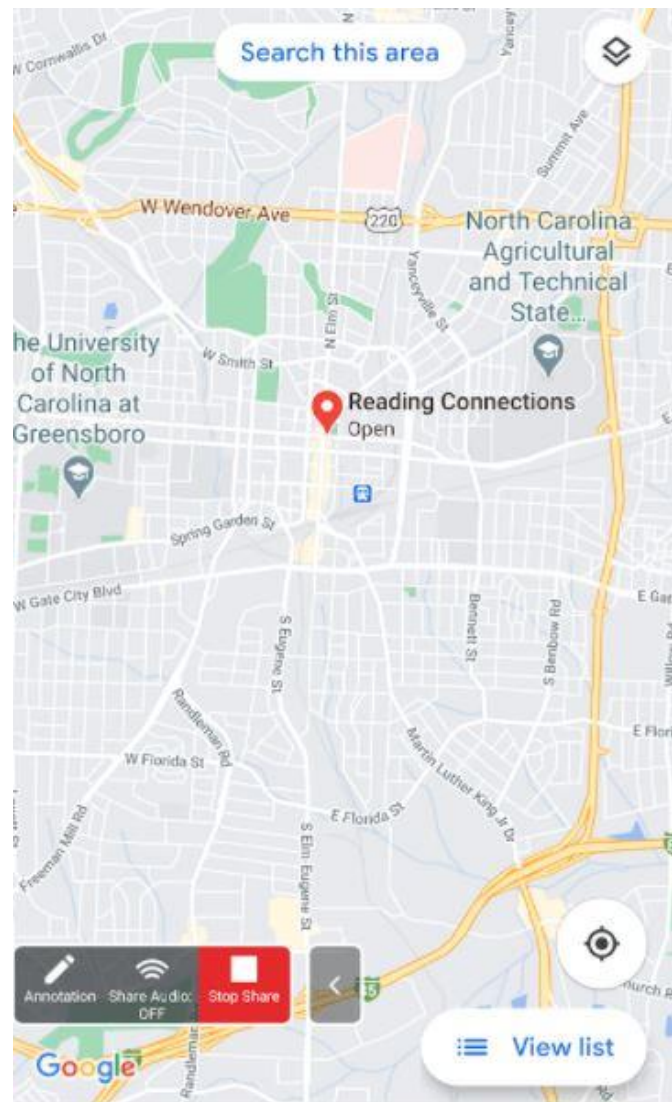
